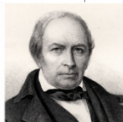

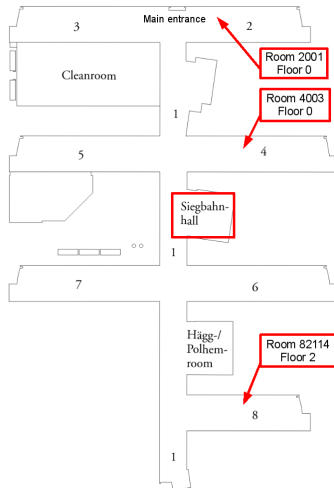

- Anders Jonas Ångström (1814–1874): Physicist and astronomer at UU. $1 \text{ Å} = 0.1 \text{ nm}$. One of the founders of the science of **spectroscopy**.
- Kai Siegbahn (1918–2007): Physicist at UU. Developed the method of Electron Spectroscopy for Chemical Analysis (ESCA)

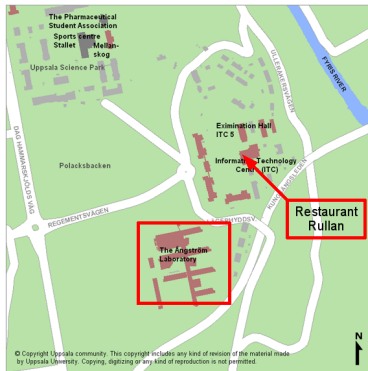
